Cabin Assignments

Cabins will be assigned based by camp, with the slight possibility to share with another camp dependent on registration numbers. Please be sure to let us know if you would like to share a cabin with another camp or participant at least one week in advance so we can appropriately assign lodging. Each cabin sleeps 15, is heated, and has attached restrooms and showers. If you have any special lodging requests/ special accommodations (i.e. medical needs, refrigerator, CPAP, etc.), please don't hesitate to reach out..

Camp Henry is a nut aware facility, meaning we do not serve nut products and ask that you do not pack any as well.

Planning for **CAMPHENRY**

Arrival & Departure

Arrival: Monday, November 7 @ 3pm

We will greet you/your group upon arrival in the main camp parking lot. From there, we will check you in, provide a map and schedule for the advance, and get you in the direction to your cabin!

If you are running late for check in, you can call 616.717.5555 to let us know, and we will be ready to greet you when you estimate your arrival.

Departure: Tuesday, November 8 @ 3pm

Directions

Camp Henry is located at 5575 Gordon Ave, Newaygo, MI 49337. Please be careful when utilizing Google Maps or other GPS/Navigation programs, as they are occasionally inaccurate getting to camp. Our main entrance is at the bottom of a winding hill (not the southern, "upper camp" entrance that goes to the Nicely Center).

FROM SOUTH (Grand Rapids): Take M-37 (Alpine Avenue) north toward Newaygo. Continue through Newaygo and over the Muskegon River and turn left at the traffic light onto M-82 (toward Fremont). Take the first right turn onto Old M-37. Take the first left onto 68th street. Travel approximately 1 mile, then turn right onto Gordon Avenue. Follow Gordon Avenue 1 ¾ miles to the Camp Henry entrance at the bottom of a short winding hill. Welcome to Camp Henry!

FROM WEST (Muskegon/Fremont): From Muskegon take US-31 north toward Ludington. Exit onto M-120 toward Fremont. Follow M-120 for approximately 30 miles, then at the 4 way stop, turn right onto M-82 toward Fremont. Continue on M-82 to and then through Fremont. Continue straight through the four way stop sign onto 48th Street. Continue on 48th street for 9 miles, and turn right at the large bend in the road to stay on 48th Street. Then, take an immediate right onto Gordon Ave. Follow Gordon Avenue for approximately 1 mile, just after the small bridge you will find the Camp Henry entrance on the right side of the road. Welcome to Camp Henry!

FROM NORTH (Big Rapids): Take 131 South toward Grand Rapids. Take the M-82 Exit toward Newaygo. Continue West on M-82 for approximately 18 miles to Newaygo. At the intersection of M-82 and M-37, turn right (north) on M-37. Follow FROM SOUTH directions above – starting with "Continue through Newaygo...".

Additional Information

- Please refrain from entering the waterfront or crossing the split rail fence/ropes to the waterfront without a Camp Henry certified lifeguard.
- If there is an emergency, Camp Henry staff will notify participants by ringing the bell in the center of camp. All participants should report to the A-Field for further instructions.
- Vehicles should remain parked in designated Camp Henry parking lots. Vehicle traffic within camp is not permitted.
- Camp Henry is not responsible for personal property brought to camp.
- Laundry facilities are not available for use at Camp Henry. In the case of an emergency, we can certainly work with you to help meet your needs.
- Food is not permitted in sleeping quarters.
- Prior to departure, please bag all trash, sweep cabins and meeting spaces, and wipe down surfaces.
